## **Management Discussion of Fund Performance**

## **Investment Objective and Strategies**

Investment Objective: Fidelity Canadian Money Market Fund (Fund) aims to achieve a high level of current income while seeking to protect capital and to maintain liquidity. The Fund invests primarily in Canadian dollar-denominated money market instruments.

Strategies: The Fund seeks to maintain a constant security price of \$10.00. When buying and selling investments, the portfolio manager follows the legal requirements for money market funds. These include minimum limits for the quality, liquidity, maturity, and diversification of a fund's investments. The Fund's assets must be invested in cash (or cash equivalents) and debt instruments that have a remaining term to maturity of not more than 365 days and that have an average term to maturity of not more than 90 days. The Fund may invest in Canadian dollar-denominated money market instruments of Canadian and foreign issuers, including short-term debt obligations of companies, such as commercial paper, governments, such as Treasury Bills, or asset-backed securities such as commercial papers. The Fund may invest up to 30% of its net assets in foreign securities and may hold cash. The Fund may also enter into repurchase agreements, reverse repurchase agreements and securities lending transactions.

## Risk

The risks associated with investing in this Fund remain as discussed in the prospectus. Any changes to the Fund over the period have not affected the overall level of risk of the Fund.

The Fund is suitable for those investors who want to seek a temporary parking spot for their cash. To invest in the Fund, investors should be willing to accept a low level of risk. The suitability of the investment has not changed from what has been disclosed in the prospectus.

## **Results of Operations**

Fidelity Canadian Money Market Fund, Series B, returned 4.40%, after fees and expenses, for the year ended June 30, 2024. The net returns of the other series of the Fund are similar to those of Series B, except for differences attributable to expense structures.

#### Market overview:

Canadian investment-grade bonds, as broadly represented by the FTSE Canada Universe Bond Index, returned 3.7% one-year period ended June 30, 2024.

Canadian investment-grade bonds rose over the period under review. High yield bonds outperformed their investment-grade peers, benefitting from higher yields and tighter credit spreads. After maintaining a policy rate of 5.0% since July 2023, the Bank of Canada (BoC) reduced the policy rate to 4.75% in June 2024. The BoC noted that there has been continued easing in inflationary pressures in Canada. The BoC also discussed that while labour market data indicates that businesses are still hiring, employment growth has lagged behind the expansion of the working age population, and wage pressures may gradually moderate as a result. Shifts in macroeconomic indicators have contributed to changing investor sentiment over the review period. This is evidenced by the Canada 10-year Treasury Bond yield, which, after a sharp decline in November and December 2023, demonstrated an overall upward trend in early 2024. The BoC's rate reduction in June 2024 caused another decline in the 10-year Treasury bond yield towards the end of the review period.

#### Portfolio changes:

At the end of the review period, exposure to banker's acceptances accounted for 24.9% of the Fund's holdings, commercial paper for 11.6%, Treasury Bills for 16.3%, Canadian provincial bonds for 6.2%, and reverse repurchase agreements for 41.6%. Portfolio managers Maura Walsh and John Carolan invest in higher-quality issuers while aiming to maintain a high degree of liquidity in the Fund. The managers also aimed to maintain flexibility in the portfolio amid market volatility by continuing to be diversified among different securities and issuers.

#### **Recent Developments**

Fidelity Canadian Money Market Fund maintained its \$10.00 security price during the review period. Portfolio managers Maura Walsh and John Carolan continue to invest in high-quality issuers and remain focused on maintaining a high degree of liquidity in the Fund. The money market portfolio management team is monitoring credit market conditions in the developed markets where the Fund maintains investments, with an aim to support portfolio safety, liquidity and stability.

Effective September 19, 2023, Anne Bell of Mississauga, Ontario, became a member of the Independent Review Committee (IRC).

## **Related Party Transactions**

## Manager and Portfolio Adviser

The Fund is managed by Fidelity Investments Canada ULC (Fidelity). Fidelity is part of a broader collection of companies collectively known as Fidelity Investments.

Fidelity provides or arranges for the provision of all general management and administrative services required by the Fund in its day—to—day operations, bookkeeping, record—keeping and other administrative services for the Fund.

Fidelity is the portfolio adviser to the Fund and it provides investment advisory services to the Fund. Fidelity has entered into sub-advisory agreements with a number of entities including Fidelity Management & Research Company LLC, to provide investment advice with respect to all or a portion of the investments of the Fund. The sub-advisors arrange for acquisition and

disposition of portfolio investments, including all necessary brokerage arrangements. The Fund pays Fidelity a monthly management and advisory fee for their services, based on the net asset value of each Series, calculated daily and payable monthly. The Fund paid Fidelity management and advisory fees of \$6,265,000 for the period ended June 30, 2024.

#### Independent Review Committee, Cross-Trading and In specie Transactions

#### Independent Review Committee

Fidelity has established an independent review committee (IRC) that acts as an impartial and independent committee to review and provide recommendations or, if appropriate, approvals respecting conflict of interest matters referred to it by Fidelity. The IRC prepares, at least annually, a report of its activities for securityholders of the Fund. The report is available at www.fidelity.ca or at the securityholder's request at no cost by contacting Fidelity, using the contact information available on the final page of this document.

#### **Cross-Trading and In specie Transactions**

The Fund received the approval and standing instructions from the IRC in order to:

(i) engage in cross-trading, which is a form of interfund trading. A cross-trade occurs when the Fund purchases or sells portfolio securities from or to another Fund, a U.S. fund or a separately managed account, through a broker;

(ii) permit the Fund, in certain circumstances, to purchase and redeem Fund securities in consideration for securities rather than cash of another investment fund not governed by NI 81-102, or a separately managed account, managed by Fidelity.

For each of the transactions in (i) and (ii) above, the IRC's standing instructions require Fidelity to act in accordance with its associated policies and procedures and applicable law, and comply with the conditions in each of the exemptive relief orders received, which, in the case of cross-trading, requires additional periodic reporting to the Ontario Securities Commission. The standing instructions also require that investment decisions in respect of these transactions (a) are free from any influence by an entity related to Fidelity and without taking into account any consideration relevant to an entity related to Fidelity; (b) represent the business judgment of Fidelity uninfluenced by considerations other than the best interests of the Fund; (c) comply with the applicable policies and procedures of Fidelity; and (d) achieve a fair and reasonable result for the Fund.

#### **Management and Advisory Fees**

Fidelity serves as manager and investment advisor of the Fund. The Fund pays Fidelity a monthly management and advisory fee for its services, based on the net asset value of each Series, calculated daily and payable monthly. Fidelity uses these management fees to pay for sales and trailing commissions to registered dealers on the distribution of the Fund securities, as well as for the general investment management expenses. Dealer compensation represents cash commissions paid by Fidelity to registered dealers during the period and includes upfront deferred sales charge and trailing commissions. This amount may, in certain circumstances, exceed 100% of the fees earned by Fidelity during the period. For new Funds or Series the amounts presented may not be indicative of longer term operating periods.

## Fidelity Canadian Money Market Fund Past Performance


